

What to do if you have COVID 19 symptoms...



Book a visit to a test site to have the test today by calling 119. Order a home test kit if you cannot get to a test site



You must self isolate until you have received your results



Everyone you live with must stay at home too until you get your results

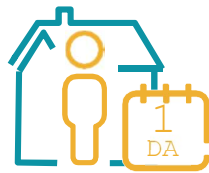


You will receive your results via email, text or phone call

After a test, what to do next...

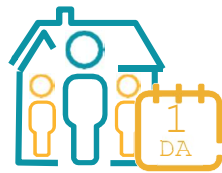


If the test comes back negative you can all stop isolating



If the test comes back positive self isolate for at least 10 days.

Self isolating means you must not leave the house, and it's a legal requirement if you test positive



Everyone you live with must stay at home for 10 days from the first day you felt poorly, even if they feel well



Keep in mind that you should try and isolate away from those that you live with



You will be contacted by text, email or phone and will be asked to provide information about anyone you have been close to recently



Inform your university/ employer/school that you have tested positive



Clean objects and surfaces you touch often, wash your hands and let fresh air into your house as much as possible



If anyone in your household shows signs or symptoms they should start to isolate and they should get a test
